

HOW TO ROCK... *a low messy pony*

What you'll need:

- La Biosthetique Beach Effect Styling Spray
- La Biosthetique Powder Spray
- Curling iron
- Hair brush
- Bobby pins
- A hair tie of preference (it could be ribbon or twine)
- Headpiece (this style works best with a floral headpiece)

Step 1: Start by spritzing the hair down with Beach Effect Styling Spray and gently blow dry into the hair. This will give you the right texture.



Step 2: Separate your hair into 4 even sections from the crown, curl each section away from your face and let the hair cool down.



Step 3: Tip your head forward upside-down and spray your roots with Powder Spray for a dusty finish.



Step 4: Flip the hair back and tong a few sections through the top randomly.

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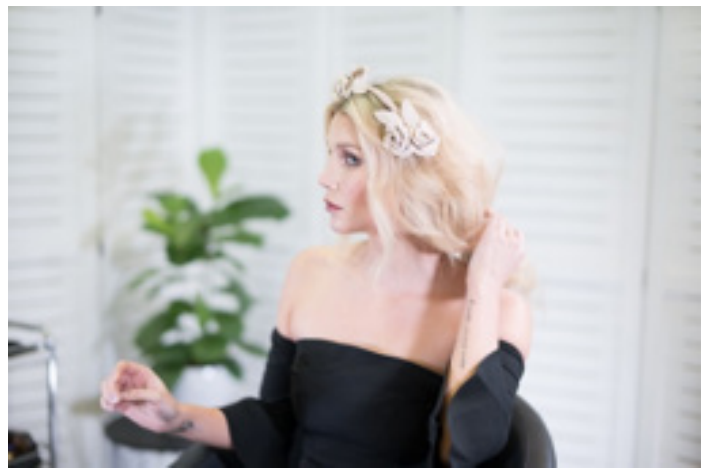
Step 5: Gather the hair loosely at the nape, while holding the pony loosely pull the hair around the crown to make the ponytail a little looser.



Step 7: Push out the hair to make a messier look if preferred.



Step 6: Tie off the hair lower than normal. We used nude coloured twine, but feel free to choose what works for you.



Step 8: Place the headpiece appropriately! We recommend our "Lucy" nude floral headpiece.



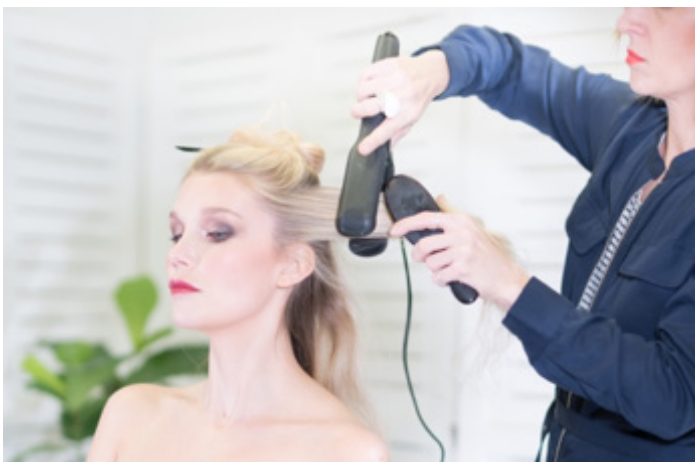
HOW TO ROCK... *a sleek pony twist*

What you'll need:

- Hair brush
- Bobby pins
- A hair tie of preference
- Hair straightener
- La Biosthetique Glossing Spray
- Headpiece (this style works best with a dramatic headpiece)

Step 1: Start by taking sections of hair and straightening from top to bottom.



Step 2: Separate your hair into 2 sections horizontally from ear to ear. Clip the top section out of the way.



Step 3: Brush the bottom section back into a ponytail and secure with an elastic band.



Step 4: Brush the top section back and into the first ponytail, secure with an elastic band to create one ponytail. Grab a small piece of hair from underneath the ponytail to wrap around the elastic band to cover it and create a finished look.

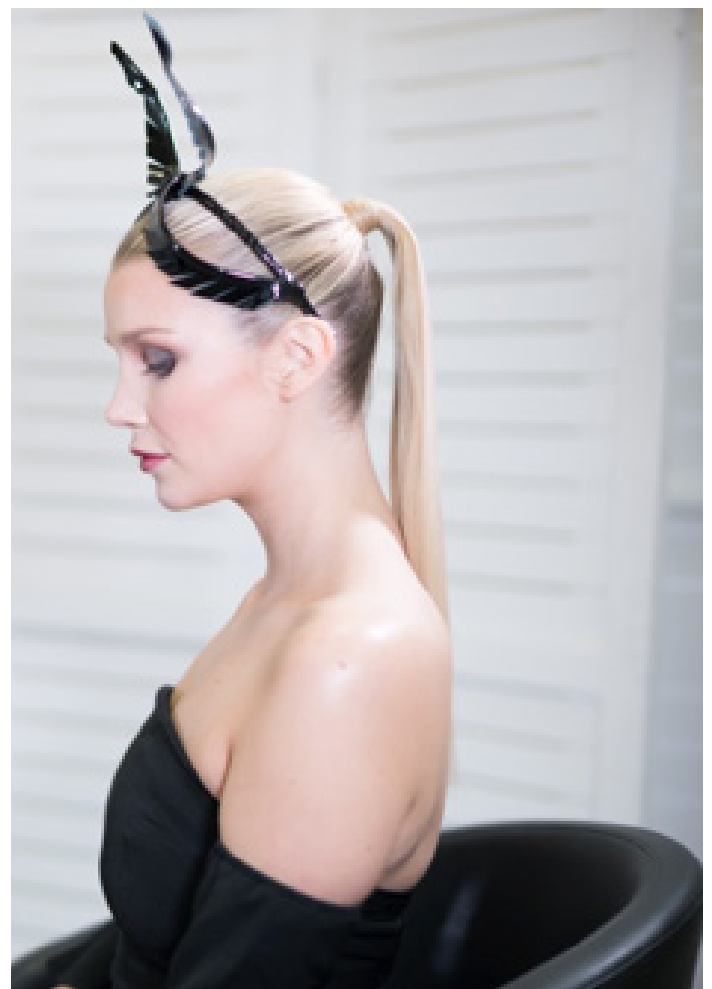
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Step 5: Finish off by adding some shine with Glossing Spray.



Step 6: Place the headpiece on your head. We recommend a bold and dramatic headpiece to complement the sleek hairstyle, like our "Saachi" to emphasise your hairstyle.



HOW TO ROCK... *soft curls*

What you'll need:

- Hair brush
- Bobby pins
- Curling iron
- La Biosthetique Molding Spray
- Headpiece (this style works best with a bold head piece)



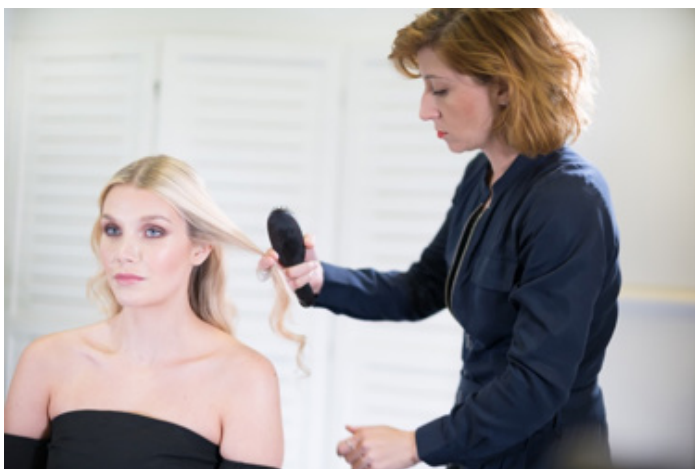

Step 2: Place the curling iron on top of the hair and wrap the hair from underneath and then over the iron. Work like this on both sides for balance. Make sure your hair is curled away from your face.

(Curls on the left side of your face need to be spiralling outwards in an anti-clockwise direction, and the curls on the right should spiral away from your face in a clockwise direction). If the section of hair is not curling properly, try using a smaller amount.

Hot Tip: Hair curled in the same direction will form a perfect wave when brushed out



Step 1: Start by sectioning the hair into fairly even sections from the face. Try starting with a section of hair 3cm x 3cm, depending on the thickness of your hair.



Step 3: Let the hair cool down to ensure curls are set. Spray with a little Moulding Spray.

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Step 4: Turn your head over and give the hair a good shake with your fingers or brush through the hair.



Step 5: Place the headpiece on your head. We recommend our stand-out piece "Rae" for a dramatic look.
